The role does involve physical activity, such as moving equipment, setting up staging, building sets, rigging, working at height etc. and you must be physically able to meet the demands of the job. You must also be able to work flexibly and as part of a team, whilst also demonstrating the leadership skills required to manage staff effectively and to tight timescales.
