Due to the nature of the role, our Volunteers must be comfortable in the water, and will need to agree to DLL carrying out a DBS check. Must be aged 14 or over.

Hours:

The vast majority of our lessons are after school hours, so from around 3:30pm onwards each day and we'd be happy to support you to volunteer for as many lessons as you'd like. We invite all our Volunteers to share their availability for a few weeks in advance, to make sure you are allocated to lessons that suit your availability.
